The New York State Organization of Bursars and Business Administrators, Inc. (NYSOBBA) is a not-for-profit corporation organized to promote excellence and professionalism among its members in carrying out student related business functions at institutions of higher education in New York.

The emphasis of NYSOBBA centers around both professional development and workshops geared toward providing individuals with training required to administer the many state and federal aid programs, cash management, student billing and collections.

Conferences are held annually throughout New York state. Each conference is planned with your needs in mind, addressing the most current issues impacting our business. Panel discussions, federal updates, customer service, and novice training are among the many topics covered.



### **Membership Benefits**

Members enjoy many benefits such as inclusion in a network of hundreds of professionals holding positions ranging from Bursars and support staff to Vice Presidents of Finance. Members typically meet twice a year for a regional meeting and a general membership conference. Members also take advantage of an annual membership directory, website and an email listserv.

Educational institutions are divided into seven regions located throughout New York state. The regions are Central, Genesee Valley, Long Island, Mid-Hudson, Northeast, Western and New York City. Each region has an elected regional director.

There are two types of memberships; institutional and business partner. Institutional membership consists of individuals who are responsible for duties in the direct administration of student related business functions at institutions of post-secondary education. Business partner members are made up of the various organizations that have a vested interest in the business that bursars and business administrators provide. Business partner members include but are not limited to banks, collection agencies, firms offering tuition payment plans, organizations providing educational loans, teller /cashiering systems and e-commerce. The New York State Higher Education Services Corporation (HESC) is also a business partner member, playing a key role as a service provider of loans and grants to all NYS institutions. NYSOBBA also has representatives from the US Department of Education who serve as regular participants in the annual conference.

### **JOHN G. KARRER SCHOLARSHIP**

NYSOBBA also funds the annual John G. Karrer NYSOBBA Scholarship. In 1993, the membership instituted a student scholarship program to recognize students enrolled in member institutions that embodied the ideals of the organization through meritorious service in an on-campus business related activity. Each of the seven regions can award two scholarships per academic year.
